11th INCPT AIIMS 2025 invites students, researchers, and professionals to submit abstracts of their original (unpublished) research for **Competitive** oral (paper) or poster presentation or innovation. Selected abstracts will be published in E-Souvenir or print version of conference proceedings with **ISBN No.** and all the presenters would be awarded with a participation certificate.

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

1. Conference registration is mandatory for abstract submission.
2. Abstract
 - Should be structured (title, authors, background, aims, methodology, results and conclusion)
 - should not exceed 250 words and
 - should be in English language
 - should be in word format,
 - written in Times New Roman; font size should be 12.
3. The abstract will be accepted through google form only. (Link below)
4. Entries from BPT students (First to fourth year) are eligible only for poster presentation.
5. Author(s) may cast their choice as paper/poster presentation, the final decision, however, shall remain with the scientific committee.
6. The submitted abstracts will undergo a vigorous peer review process by the scientific committee whose decision will be considered final.
7. Abstract will stand cancelled if use of AI/ Plagiarism is detected. NO FURTHER NEGOTIATION WILL BE ENTERTAINED.

8. Only one author will be allowed to present the paper. Mention the name of presenting author along with the abstract. The presenting author may/may not be the first author of the study. Presenting author will be considered as the corresponding author. NO CHANGES WILL BE ENTERTAINED LATER
9. No author would be allowed to PRESENT more than one paper/poster.
10. Oral Presentation:
 - Oral presentation would be done in PPT format (8-10 slides). Emphasize on methods and results. Be sure your visuals are clear and legible.
 - Each speaker will have 8 minutes for presentation followed by 2 minutes discussion
 - Bring a copy of your PPT with you on flash drive or Pen drive to the event for paper presentation. INTERNET FACILITY WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.
11. Poster Presentation:
 - Abstracts selected for poster presentation are required to make a printed poster of size 3 x 2 feet (in portrait orientation). Be sure your visuals are clear and legible. Posters will be displayed at the conference venue and presenting author would require to present the same followed by discussion with the judge(s).
12. Innovations:
 - Innovations are invited including but not limited to any novel technique/ process/ protocol/ device/ tool for assessment, screening, treatment, management, or evaluation in the domain of physiotherapy. A brief write-up of around 150-200 words (preferably with pictures of the innovation). IT WOULD BE ATTEMPTED TO INCORPORATE MOST OF THE INNOVATIONS FOR PRESENTATION. Duration of presentation would be 8 minutes including demonstration, if any.
13. Oral, Poster & Innovation presentations are of equal standing and judged by the same standards. There is more room in the program for posters than the other formats of presentations.
14. The spellings of the name of presenter and the research topic will be printed on the certificate as submitted by the author. NO REQUEST FOR THE CHANGE OF SAME WILL BE ENTERTAINED LATER.
15. It is the author(s)' responsibility to submit the accurate content of the abstract. ABSTRACT WILL BE PUBLISHED AS IT IS SUBMITTED WITHOUT EDITING.
